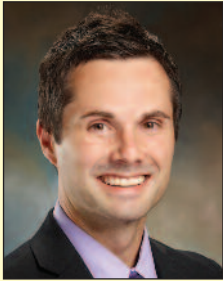
to Victor Duarte, IGT's Global Chief Product Officer, Gaming, and will be based in Las Vegas.

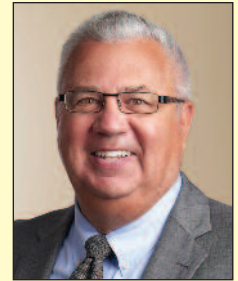

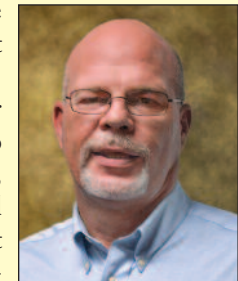
Paragon Casino Resort Names Billy Hendrix Vice President of Food & Beverage
